Campbell GOP seeks female strength

COLD SPRING - The Campbell County GOP has taken another aggressive move toward party building by forming a women's club.

The first meeting of the Campbell County Republican Women's Club will be held at 5:30 p.m. July 8 at Barleycorn's on Industrial Road (Ky. 1998) in Cold Spring. The featured speaker will be Senate President Pro Tem Katie Stine, R-Southgate.

Campbell County GOP Chairman Jeff Kidwell said in a statement that the organization was formed "to give like-minded Republican women in Campbell County a vehicle to promote conservative Republican family values and to assist the Republican Party of Campbell County to support and elect Republican Candidates."

The idea for the group was conceived by the Campbell County Republican Party Executive Committee and is being implemented by Campbell County Circuit Clerk Taunya Nolan Jack; Marilyn McGinley of Cold Spring; party youth chairwoman Elizabeth Kidwell; and party vice-chairwoman Wini Stine among others.

The Campbell County Democratic Party has operated a Women's Club for years. The GOP organization is another move by Kidwell and party leaders to build the party, raise money, organize elections and recruit candidates, volunteers and members.

The party recently held a fundraiser for its Lincoln 100 Club, which raises \$100 from 100 contributors. It also has improved its techniques in door-to-door campaigning and using technology to contact voters.

"I believe that the Campbell County Republican Women's Club will be a big success and I look forward to watching the progress as the group grows," Kidwell said. "Taunya and Marilyn have put a lot of work getting this off the ground and I am pleased to see the group starting off with such a prominent and highly respected guest. I believe this group will be very successful and will be a benefit for our party."
