School tax collection rates to be reduced

Beginning the 2013 tax season, all school systems that the Sheriff's Office collects taxes for will see their tax collection fee paid to the Campbell County Sheriff's office reduced from 2.5% to 1.5% annually. Those school systems are: Campbell County Schools, Silver Grove Schools, Dayton Independent and Bellevue Independent school systems.



It is our hope that this reduction in fees will assist our schools in the retention of high quality educators and the continuance of character-building programs for our most valuable resource — our children.

The savings to these schools from this reduction is approximately \$225,000. This fee reduction for our schools is the result of streamlining our operations across the board.



You will be seeing a lot more of these newly marked vehicles around Campbell County in days to come. These aren't new vehicles, just new designs to spruce up the old ones.

It is important for Campbell County citizens to know that we are in their neighborhoods working for them daily and since many of our old vehicles were unmarked, we were virtually invisible to our citizens. Say "hi" when you see us out working in your neighborhood.

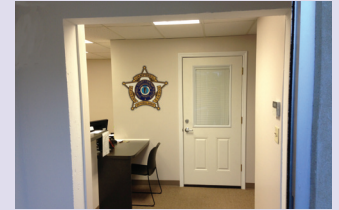
Alexandria office hours expanded!

The Campbell County Sheriff's Alexandria satellite office has new expanded hours of operation. The office located at 8330 West Main Street in Alexandria is now open from 8 am to 4 pm Monday through Friday and is open from 9 am to 12 noon Saturdays.

We are glad to see so many of our Campbell County citizens taking advantage of this new office!

After opening with a reduced set of hours in order to analyze the traffic patterns and usage of the new

office, it became pretty clear that there was a need for the office to offer the additional hours. The new office offers all of the same services offered at the Sheriff's office main location.

New Sheriff's Office Iphone, Ipad and Android mobile app!

Working on the project since early 2013, the Campbell County Sheriff's Office has released a mobile application for Iphone, Ipad and Android mobile devices to better inform and protect Campbell County citizens.

The application is called "Mobile Patrol" and provides access to valuable Campbell County information: information on current prisoners held in the Campbell County Detention Center; victim notification using the VINE system to let victims of crime know when someone is going to be released from jail; sex offender tracking in your neighborhood (by October 2013), complete with offences, addresses and more; Campbell County's most wanted; top 10 child support offenders; special crime tip system; contact information for Campbell County offices like Sheriff, Clerk, County Attorney, Detention Center and more; and a special alert section to notify Campbell County citizens of alert situations like Amber alerts, Golden alerts and weather emergency conditions.

"The Campbell County Sheriff's Office is the first law enforcement agency in Kentucky to offer this powerful tool to their citizens, so we're pretty excited to see this idea become a reality. One of the best parts of offering



this new access is that there is no cost to the taxpayers for this technology," said Sheriff Kidwell.
